#	Questions	Answers
1.	Should payments for co-payments/deductibles for medications which the ADAP produced program income revenue from still be reported? For example, the reimbursement from the third-party payor was more than the total acquisition + copay/deductible costs.	<p>No. If there isn't a cost to the program, the service should not be reported. For AIDS Drug Assistance Programs (ADAPs) that are direct purchase for copays, the insurance reimbursement usually exceeds the cost of the medication. The program income should be reported in the Recipient Report.</p> <p>The clients involved are still reported in the ADR. A RWHAP ADAP client is any person who has been determined eligible to receive RWHAP ADAP services, regardless of whether the person received RWHAP ADAP services during the reporting period.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to the ADR Instruction Manual or reach out to the DISQ Team.</p>
