

Improvements in Completeness for Select Data Elements

HAB’s RSR data quality goal is for all providers to have **at least 90% known values** – that is valid data excluding missing or unknown values – for **five critical client-level data elements**: federal poverty level, health insurance status, housing status, CD4 count, and viral load. These data elements are required to establish Ryan White eligibility and demonstrate critical HIV health outcomes.

Chart 1: Improvements in Known Rates for Demographic Data Elements

Providers are reporting more known responses for key demographic data elements. This chart shows a continual increase in known rates from 2010 to 2013 for enrollment status, housing status, medical insurance, and poverty level.

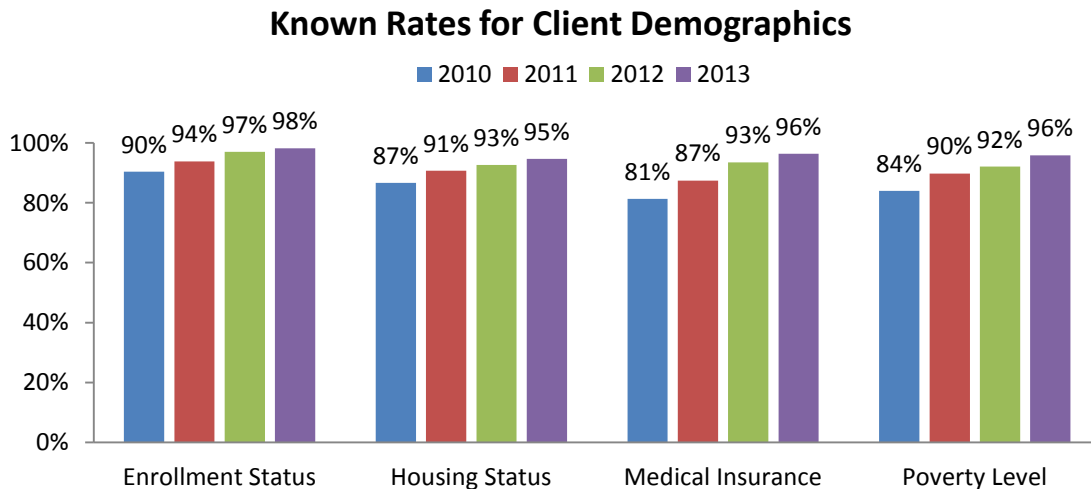


Chart 2: Improvements in Known Rates for CD4 Count and Viral Load: Remaining Challenges

This chart shows that although grantees have struggled with reporting viral load test results and CD4 count test results, known rates from 2010 to 2013 have improved over time.
