

HIV stigma is rooted in a fear of HIV and supported by systems that "otherized" people with HIV.







Duplicate Services are Inefficient

- People with HIV and those who could benefit from HIV prevention have similar needs
 - Duplicate services/programs are inefficient
 - Jurisdictions and CBOs cite siloed funding as a barrier to status neutral programming
- The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) is a great model
 - RWHAP-funded facilities use a medical home model, offering comprehensive,
 patient-centered care¹
 - Most service-provision, other than testing, is for people with diagnosed HIV



Status Neutral HIV Prevention and Care




Follow CDC guidelines to test people for HIV. Regardless of HIV status, quality care is the foundation of HIV prevention and effective treatment. Both pathways provide people with the tools they need to stay healthy and stop HIV.

Benefits of the Status Neutral Approach

- Dramatically decrease new HIV infections
- Supports and enables optimal health through continual engagement in comprehensive, "whole person" care and supports syndemic-related services and health promotion
- Increases opportunities for more efficient service delivery
- Improves health equity given intersection of HIV stigma and other biases







Making HIV testing simple, accessible, and routine.



Quickly linking people with HIV to care and treatment, and re-engaging those who have stopped receiving care.

CDC's Approach



Increasing availability and use of PrEP among populations who could benefit most.



Partnering with other agencies and working with local communities to implement SSPs where they are needed and permitted by law.



Ensuring all jurisdictions have the capacity to identify, investigate, and respond to potential HIV outbreaks quickly.

Benefits of Status Neutral Approach

- Reduce institutionalized stigma for people living with HIV
- Create efficiencies improve resource utilization
- Gain insights from parallel service delivery
- Become more whole person-focused embrace the person; service delivery is secondary






Benefits Of Whole Person Focused Approach

- Assess our models of care through a new lens
- Support self-esteem by normalizing conversations and strategies to optimize health
- Focus on sexual health and pleasure
 harm reduction
- Respect the individual and their autonomy



Lessons Learned from Implementing Status Neutral

- Full integration requires a thorough, deliberate approach
- Robust collaboration is needed (internal/external)
- Messaging and programming have to align
- May require use of multiple sources of funding




Broadening Eligibility in Detroit

Transgender Women
Engagement and Entry to
Care (T.W.E.E.T.) broadened
eligibility for group
for transgender women of
color to include health and
wellness.

The focus on positive HIV status created a stigma and limited participation.

The site was able to draw from multiple funding streams in order to implement TWEET with a status-neutral approach.


